Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent no.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has produced a photocopy of the FDR in terms of order dated 16.5.2016 and submits that inadvertently, the FDR has been prepared for a term of one year instead of three years. However, he undertakes to get it renewed for a term of three years.

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Subhash Chand, D.S.P., Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar along with the statements of petitioners as well as respondent no.4 to the effect that the petitioners do not apprehend any danger to their life and liberty and therefore, the petitioners do not require any protection.

Photocopy of the FDR as well as statements so furnished are taken on record.

In view of the statements of the petitioners, no further order is called for.

The present petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioners shall get the FDR converted for a term of three years and shall produce a copy of the same with the registry.
