The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. March 12, 2016 for having issued a death certificate of Chaman Lal to the effect that he died on May 25, 2014 due to heart attack. On the basis of said false document, an attempt was made to claim the benefit of insurance in the name of said Chaman Lal by Shankar, who is still alive.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he had issued fake death certificate of Chaman Lal for helping accused Shankar in getting insurance claim of death of Chaman Lal.

Since no wrongful loss could be caused to the insurance Company, the mischief having been detected initially, petitioner having remained in custody for the last more than 2 ½ months, can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur.
