Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for registration of case for commission of offence under Section 420 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been cheated to the tune of Rs.8,30,000/- by respondent No.4, who is working as Deputy Superintendent of Police with the Punjab police and presently posted at Ferozepur. He further states that he has allured the petitioner for the said amount so as to get the daughter of the petitioner recruited in BSF. He further states that the petitioner has already

approached to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur for redressal of his grievance vide representation dated 19.4.2016 (Annexure P-2) but no action has been taken on the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Though for registration of the case, the law provides a legal mechanism but without expressing any opinion of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to take note of the contents of the representation dated 19.4.2016 (Annexure P-2) and act in accordance with law.
