This order shall dispose of CRM No.M-16948 of 2016 titled as Gurbax Singh Vs. State of Punjab and CRM No.M-16975 of 2016 titled as Dilbagh Singh @ Maru Vs. State of Punjab as both these connected petitions have been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioners herein pending trial in case FIR No.261 dated 12.12.2014, under Sections 302/307/324/452/427/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

Briefly, it may be noticed that the FIR came to be registered on the statement of Mukhtool Singh in relation to an occurrence dated 12.12.2014.

Deceased in the case is Narinder Singh i.e. brother of the complainant.

Insofar as Gurbax Singh i.e. petitioner in CRM No.M-16948 of

2016 is concerned, the role attributed is of being armed with a *datar* and having inflicted injury upon Baljit Singh son of Amar Singh. Deceased, Narinder Singh is stated to have died of firm-arm injuries. No injury has been attributed to Gurbax Singh on the person of the deceased.

Insofar as Dilbabh Singh @ Maru i.e. petitioner in CRM No.M-16975 of 2016 is concerned, even though his name figures in the FIR but no injury/overt act/direct role has been attributed towards deceased or for that matter to the injured. At best his presence has been recorded on the date and time of occurrence.

Both the petitioners herein were arrested on 14.03.2016.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Agyapal Singh would submit that investigation in the case is complete, challan has been prepared and would be presented shortly.

Without making any observations on merits, prayer made in these two connected petitions is accepted.

Petitions are allowed. Gurbax Singh i.e. petitioner in CRM No.M-16948 of 2016 and Dilbagh Singh @ Maru i.e. petitioner in CRM No.M-16975 of 2016 be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Disposed of.
