Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondent Nos.3 and 4 to provide the appropriate medical treatment to the accused namely Ranjit Singh, who was convicted in case FIR No.100, dated 07.06.2012, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that medical treatment may be provided to the accused-Ranjit Singh.

In view of above, the Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar where the accused Ranjit Singh, convict is stated to have been confined is directed to provide the necessary medical treatment, as per law and if necessary, get him checked from the Doctors.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will be treated as an instrument to get him admitted on frivolous grounds in hospital. If there is any necessity to admit him in the hospital then to act as per law.
