JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. petitioner has sought the direction to official respondents No.1 to 4 to register an FIR against respondent No.7 and to get conducted the proper enquiry through some Senior Officers of the rank of IPS.

In response to notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of Gurmit Singh PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Amargarh, District Sangrur has filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4.

A glance at the aforesaid reply reveals that instant case was thoroughly investigated, FIR was registered and investigation was conducted. Injured Harpreet Singh, Sumanpreet Singh sons of petitioners were under treatment at present they are quite well and are at home.

Alleged Swift Car was not involved in the incident. Death of Kuldeep Singh occurred due to striking of motor cycle make Bullet being driven by him with a Canter but not with the alleged Swift Car. During inquiry, the allegations could not be established. As a result thereof untraced report has already been furnished in the Court of Jurisdictional Magistrate.

In view of the aforesaid facts, instant petition has rendered infructuous and same is dismissed as such.

However, petitioners shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to him under the law.
