Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the order dated 17.05.2016 made by this Court granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Avtar Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and custody is not required.

On the contrary, learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the grant/confirmation of ad-interim anticipatory bail since the offence is serious and no relief of pre-arrest bail can be given to such offenders who have caused serious injuries to the complainant. Taking into consideration the overall material on record and the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated with the Investigating Officer and looking to the nature of

allegation in the instant case, I am inclined to confirm the order dated 17.05.2016 made by this Court.

In that view of the matter, the interim order dated 17.05.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
