Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner-accused-Ranjeet in case FIR No. 144, dated 09.03.2015, for offence punishable under Section 136 of Electricity Act, 2003, registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

As per case of the prosecution, the petitioner-accused-Ranjeet surfaced in the investigation on the disclosure statement of the co-accused-Gurcharan Singh that the petitioner is involved in the theft of coils of the transformers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 10.10.2015 and investigation is over.

Learned State counsel, assisted by ASI Aman Parkash does not dispute the above said factual contentions and further states that the

petitioner is involved in ten other criminal cases of similar nature. It is also pointed out that six out of eight prosecution witnesses have been examined and the remaining two have been summoned for 04.06.2016.

Keeping in view the number of cases registered against the petitioner and the fact that trial is at the fag end, no case for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
