The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.95 dated 20.10.2011, under Sections 420/406 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana.

Allegations against the present petitioner as also her husband, namely, Amrik Singh are with regard to having misappropriated a sum of Rs.14 lacs approximately on the pretext of settling the complainant abroad.

This Court by taking note of the fact that even minor daughter of the petitioner was incarcerated along with her had granted concession of interim bail in the light of order dated 25.05.2015.

During the subsequent dates, husband of the petitioner, namely, Amrik Singh has chosen not to join trial proceedings.

On the last date of hearing i.e. on 31.03.2016, counsel for the petitioner had prayed for one last opportunity to complete instructions as to

whether the petitioner was ready and willing to make over to the complainant at least a part payment of the amount that was alleged to have been misappropriated.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner today would submit that her husband Amrik Singh is still in a foreign country i.e. Uganda. There is no assurance coming forth with regard to her husband joining trial proceedings.

Confronted with such situation and circumstances, counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage and undertakes that the petitioner who was otherwise availing the concession of interim bail, would surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks from today.

The present petition seeking benefit of regular bail is dismissed as withdrawn as per prayer made by counsel at this stage.
