Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct enquiry/investigation and initiate appropriate criminal proceedings against respondents No. 4 to 7 for having committed offences under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B IPC as respondent No.4 has sold the property of the petitioners to other private respondents by preparing forged and fabricated sale deeds.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has

been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though various representations dated 02.05.2016 (Annexures P-3 to P-5) were moved to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, Punjab, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representations dated 02.05.2016 (Annexures P-3 to P-5) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
