JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") seeking direction to the official respondents to conclude inquiry into the complaint (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner in accordance with Chapter XII of the Cr.P.C.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that though complaint dated 31.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) was moved to

Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka but without giving any final verdict with regard to the fact that whether a case is made out under the provisions of IPC or not, the parties have simply been directed to approach the Civil Court.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, Tehsil and District Fazilka, Punjab, to get an inquiry conducted afresh and to deal with the same in accordance with Chapter XII of the Cr.P.C. as well as to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
