HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondent No.2 to provide security to the life of the petitioners and their family members from the hand of respondents No.4 to 6 and further restrained respondent No.3 not to involve the petitioners in some false case at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners confined his prayer to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. He further states that since the petitioners are being threatened at the behest of respondents No.4 to 6 and

being compelled to submit the resignation of petitioner No.1 from the post of Sarpanch to which she has duly been elected, they have already approached respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur vide representation dated 9.5.2016 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the contents of the representation, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-SSP, Ferozepur to take note of the representation dated 9.5.2016 (Annexure P-3) and to ensure the protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners.
