Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing/setting aside the order dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala whereby petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person pursuant to proclamation proceedings under Section 82 Cr.P.C. initiated against him in FIR No.105 dated 20.05.2014 for offences under Sections 22/61/85 NDPS Act registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 18.05.2016 passed by this Court, petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and the trial Court has admitted him on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds.
