Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.47 dated 04.07.2014, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Jarukian, District Mansa.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is of 1200 tablets of Lomotil.

Report of the Chemical Examiner having been received, the same has been found to be containing diphenoxylate hydrochloride.

The alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is heavy and commercial in nature.

Under such circumstances, prayer made in the present petition seeking benefit of regular bail is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
