The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondent Nos.5 to 8.

Counsel has contended that on the basis of a complaint filed by the petitioner even FIR was registered against the private respondents but SHO Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana is in connivance with the private respondents and as such a fair investigation in the matter is not being conducted.

Without even going into the merits of the case and without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the matter in the light of a representation dated 08.06.2015 at Annexure P-3 which is stated to have already been

submitted.

It would be open for respondent No.3 to verify the contents of such representation and to thereafter take action as he may deem fit and as per law.

Disposed of.
