This is a petition for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 73 dated 06.07.2014, under Sections 302/365/201 IPC registered at Police Station Nahianwala, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is a blind murder case which is now being sought to be pinned against the petitioner on the basis of very dubious circumstantial evidence and the trial is nowhere near conclusion. Further the petitioner has been in custody since 08.07.2014. Learned DAG, on instructions from HC Nirmaljeet Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I do not deem it appropriate to deny

the concession of bail to the present petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
