Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass the petitioner and his family members without any rhyme and reason and further to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondent No.6.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 5 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a

representation dated 09.05.2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka but till date no action has been taken.

5. Without expressing any opinion on the merits as well as the allegations contained in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, Punjab, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 09.05.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
