Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 to 6.

Learned State counsel has produced the photocopies of affidavits of petitioners as well as respondent no.4 to 6, which are taken on record.

Petitioners in their affidavits have deposed that they are living happily and there is no danger to their life from anyone, whereas the

private respondents have deposed that they have no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the affidavits of petitioners as well as respondents no.4 to 6, but without commenting upon the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the authorities concerned in case they apprehend any danger to their life and liberty.
