Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.21 dated 03.03.2015, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Valtoha, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is of 260 grams of intoxicant powder which upon receipt of Chemical Examiner report was found to be containing salt of alprazolam.

The alleged recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as commercial in nature.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is allowed. Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
