This order shall dispose of CRM-M-16236-2014-Javed and another Versus State of Haryana and others and CRM-M-954-2016-Hamid Versus State of Haryana and others.

Prayer in these petitions filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.434 dated 02.11.2013 under Sections 363, 366 IPC and Section 18 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station Hatin, District Palwal.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jan Mohd. states that in the instant cases, the trial is at fag end of its conclusion as all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and it is because of order dated 13.01.2016 passed in the connected case i.e. CRM-M-954-2016-Hamid Versus State of Haryana and others, the final order could not be pronounced.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press these petitions, however, seek liberty to take all possible pleas as available to the petitioners under law including the factum of marriage between Javed and Sanjida.

Dismissed as not pressed with liberty aforesaid.
