This is a petition for quashing the FIR No. 156 dated 16.07.2014 registered at Police Station Uklana, District Hisar under Sections 498-A/406/323/506 IPC and the subsequent proceedings arising thereof.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no allegations of demand had been levelled against the petitioner and the police has already given a clean chit to the father-in-law, mother-in-law, Rakesh and Sanjeev, a friend of the husband. It was urged that the complainant wanted to hide her own temperament and when the petitioner wanted to bring her back she refused to join his company and the FIR has been registered after 5 months of leaving the matrimonial home. He further contends that challan has been presented against the husband and charge has been framed.

The FIR incorporates the allegations of demand of dowry against the husband. He has been accused of beating the complainant. The police has investigated the matter and has filed the challan and charge has been framed. The petition can not be quashed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. as the petitioner does not fulfill the condition laid down in ***State of Haryana and others Vs. Ch. Bhajan Lal and others, AIR 1992 SC 604.***

The petition is dismissed.
