This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.538 dated 30.08.2015, registered under Sections 392/397/34 IPC, at Police Station City Sonipat.

As per allegations, the complainant and his driver has started from Moga in a Bolero vehicle. When they reached near Shani Temple, Sonipat, they were stopped by two boys on a motorcycle, one of whom pointed a pistol on the head of the complainant and the remaining caught hold the driver and threw him outside the vehicle. Thereafter, they escaped.

Amit and another boy run away in the vehicle and remaining two boys fled

away.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 30.08.2015 and no other case is registered against him. Apart from the statement of the co-accused, no other evidence has been unearthed against him.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions has accepted this factual assertion.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
