This is a petition which has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.163 dated 20.09.2015 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the parties

have compromised the matter and that the petitioner has been in custody since 01.10.2015.

Learned counsel for the complainant has accepted these facts. Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh states that she has no knowledge about this fact and therefore is not in a position to deny it.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
