Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in a case arising out of FIR No.02 dated 11.01.2016, registered at Police Station Women, Patiala, District Patiala, who have been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC.

At the very outset, learned State, on instructions from HC Sukhpreet Singh, has informed that the compromise has been effected between the parties. In this regard, the complainant has given an affidavit. At this stage, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 18.05.2016, passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim

anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
