The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 361 dated 10.10.2015 registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal, Haryana under Section 306 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 10.10.2015. He further contends that charge had been framed long back and the prosecution has not been able to examine the main witnesses despite taking number of adjournments. The counsel has placed on record copy of the order dated 16.05.2016 to show that witnesses have been served for that day but they did not turned up and service was not effected on the other three private witnesses. He has placed on record documents to show that the deceased was suffering from problem and she was taking treatment. The counsel refers to the treatment taken in June 2015. The incident is of October 2015. The marriage was over 10 years old and there were two children. The wife had committed suicide.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
