Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3 and his subordinate staff, who are harassing and threatening the present petitioner and his family members and further to direct respondent No. 2 for taking legal action on the representation of the petitioner.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has

been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 27.02.2016 (Annexure P-) was moved to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, Punjab, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 27.02.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
