HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 to 6 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.7 to 20.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondents No.7 to 20 are threatening the petitioner and her family member and she is not being allowed by them to enter in village Mari, District Bathinda or in the agriculture land under her ownership.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already approached

respondent No.3-Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Maur Mandi, District Bathinda by way of representation dated 10.5.2016 (Annexure P-5), but no action thereon has been taken by the police so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 6 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Mikhail Kad, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the contents of application (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
