The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in cross version case recorded on the statement of Gurdeep Singh alleging that the petitioner alongwith 4 others had attacked the complainant, armed with datar and revolver and assaulted him. Petitioner was allegedly armed with the revolver and pointed the same on the complainant and assaulted him by kicks on his back and stomach.

Perusal of the police file indicates that no specific injury is attributed to co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Parveen Kumar. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 27.08.2015. It is not out of place to mention here that main case under Section 307 IPC was registered at the instance of Parveen Kumar on the side of petitioner.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.
