Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of appropriate order or direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take appropriate action on complaint filed by petitioner No.1 dated 04.04.2016 (Annexure P-1).

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though complaint/representation dated 04.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved

to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, Punjab, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in representation dated 04.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
