Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 for investigation in cae FIR No. 100 dated November 14, 2014 under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on vide DDR No. 13, dated January 14, 2015), registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala in accordance with law and to take appropriate action against the accused persons.

2. Learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of an affidavit of Jagbinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division City Batala, Police District Batala. The same is taken on record.

3. A perusal of reply reveals that inquiry was got conducted from Amrik Singh Pawar, PPS the then Superintendent of Police (Inv), Batala, who

has recommended the filing of cancellation report. A detailed inquiry report is Annexure R-1/T. It has further been averred in the reply that inquiry report submitted by Superintendent of Police (Inv), Batala has been approved by the then Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala on June 11, 2015 and SHO, Police Station Sekhwan has been directed to proceed further as per inquiry report. The cancellation report is likely to be presented shortly in the concerned court.

4. In view of reply and submission of cancellation report, instant petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

5. However, learned court dealing with cancellation report is directed to grant an ample opportunity to the petitioner to hear and present his case before passing any final order.
