On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal Deputy Advocate General, Haryana who is present in Court took notice on behalf of the State.

Heard the submissions made on the either side.

The role attributed to the petitioner Dilbagh Singh is that he joined the other co-accused and caused simple injury on the persons of Samay, Ajay, Rakesh and Sohan. The co-accused Shubham and Rohit were already granted bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, I am of the view that the applicant has made out a case for anticipatory bail. Anticipatory bail is granted in the following terms:

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigation Officer. He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer. He shall also comply with the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Petition is allowed.
