The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 117 dated 20.09.2015 under Sections 363, 366, 376, 109, 120-B IPC, Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel has pointed out that initially pursuant to the order dated 08.02.2016 passed by the Additional Session Judge , Bathinda, the petitioner had join the investigation. He further submits that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he facilitated the main accused Kewal Singh and who had enticed away the prosecutrix. He further submits that the trial against the remaining accused is going on and nothing has to be recovered from the petitioner and supplementary challan has already been filed by the Police.

State counsel submits that the petitioner is not required and nothing has to be recovered from him. The petitioner would appear before the trial Court on 04.08.2016, i.e. the date already fixed and on his appearance he shall be released on bail on his furnishing bonds to its satisfaction.

The petition is allowed.
