Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 1.2.2012. The period of detention is certainly a matter of concern warranting grant of bail to the petitioner. The petitioner is alleged to have fired three shots from his pistol causing the death of Mewa Singh.

On asking of the Court, State counsel informs that all the prosecution witnesses except one have been examined. The case was fixed before the trial Court for today for examination of remaining two witnesses out of which one is stated to have been examined.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the trial Court shall conclude the trial within a period of two months after the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court. In case the trial is not concluded within the period stated above, this Court will be constrained to grant bail to the petitioner on account of delay in adjudication of the matter, on application for bail being filed before this Court.
