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By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.08, dated 14.02.2016, registered under Sections 323, 392, 394, 397, 201 and 379-B(2) IPC, at Police Station Khilchian, District Amritsar Rural.

It is contended that no MLR was conducted on the person of injured. The petitioner is not involved in any other FIR and he is in custody since 15.02.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the

prayer of bail and states that the challan stands presented; charges have been framed; out of total 10 witnesses, no one has been examined.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 15.02.2016 and out of total 10 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far, therefore, it can safely be inferred that the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
