Present petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners as they have been receiving continuous threats of physical harm from respondent No. 5 and their associates, who are proclaiming themselves as human rights activists.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4, only at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits he feels satisfied in case direction is given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala to decide the representations dated 17.09.2015 and 10.10.2015 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, Punjab, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representations dated 17.09.2015 and 10.10.2015 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
