Petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for ordering the quashing of complaint dated 02.07.2012, summoning order dated 22.08.2013 as well as subsequent proceedings arising out of complaint "IPC Comp. No.21 dated 02.07.2012, RBT 08/12 dated 02.07.2013 titled as Mohinder Singh Vs. Hajura Singh etc." pending in the Court of Ld. JMIC, Garhshankar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to the extent that the trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial as the complaint is pending since the year 2012 and summoning order has been passed in 2013 and so many adjournments have been given to the complainant to complete pre-charge evidence, but he is delaying with the complaint's proceedings intentionally.

Keeping in view the above said facts, learned trial Court is directed to expedite the disposal of this complaint by giving short adjournments and if requires to adjourn the case on day-to-day basis. The trial Court is also directed not to deffer the examination of any witness at the instance of the counsel for the complaint or at the defence counsel.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stand disposed of.
