Petitioners seek quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Case has been called out twice since morning. None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners. Similar was the situation on the last date of hearing. Learned State counsel has pointed out the allegations levelled in the FIR. According to him, petitioner-Amrik Singh took the signatures of the complainant on certain papers in order to get divorce. The signatures were taken on the pretext that he had to get Rs.70,000/- from the Government as per shagun scheme. Being an illiterate woman, she put the signatures on the papers. Thereafter, he eloped with a girl-Punam Kumari. Complainant lodged the FIR on the ground that her signatures had been obtained fraudulently.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations, I am of the considered view that no case is made out for quashing the FIR.
