KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the building used for running the Anganwari Centre has been demolished. A complaint dated 11.4.2016 (Annexure-P-2) was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran and another complaint dated 11.4.2016 (Annexure-P-3) was made to the Station House Officer, Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran. However, no action has been taken thereon so far.

In these circumstances, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, is directed to look into the complaint and dispose of the same in accordance with law within three months, without being influenced of the fact that the petitioner has approached this Court.
