Petition qua petitioner no.4-Balvir Kaur stands dismissed
vide order dated 21.07.2015.

Present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC on behalf of the accused Sukhwinder Kaur (petitioner no.1), Jaspal Kaur (petitioner no.2) and Karamjit Singh (petitioner no.3) in case FIR No.3 dated 3.4.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station NRI Bathinda.

The complainant Mehar Singh is 73 years old NRI. He had admittedly executed a registered power of attorney dated 12.11.2010 in favour of petitioner no.1 Sukhwinder Kaur. It is also admitted fact that on 30.04.2009 the marriage between complainant Mehar Singh and accused Balvir Kaur (petitioner no.4) was registered with Registrar of Marriages.

The said accused Balvir Kaur is none else than mother of accused Sukhwinder Kaur.

The allegations are that inspite of the power of attorney having been cancelled on 27.6.2012, Sukhwinder Kaur has fraudulently sold 29 Kanals of land in favour of her accused mother-in-law Jaspal Kaur vide sale deed dated 2.7.2012. Further allegation in the alternative is that even the sale consideration has not been forwarded to the Mehar Singh-complainant by petitioner no.2-Sukhwinder Kaur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the dispute is essentially of civil nature. He further submits that petitioner no.4-Balvir Kaur was arrested and all investigations qua her are over. He in the light of the stand of the State that the sale consideration is to be recovered does not press this petition qua petitioner no.1-Sukhwinder Kaur.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Fauji Ram submits that rest of the petitioners have joined investigation and the evidence being documentary nothing else is to be recovered from them.

In view the above, present petition qua **petitioner no.1** is hereby **dismissed as not pressed** whereas interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 20th of May, 2015 qua petitioners no.2 & 3 namely Jaspal Kaur and Karamjit Singh is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
