JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for handing over the investigation of the case bearing FIR No. 191, dated 01.05.2016, under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 148, 149, 302, 323, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Pehowa from a high rank officer like Superintendent of Police or independent agency like the State Vigilance Bureau, Haryana for fair investigation.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though a detailed

representation dated 08.05.2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved to the Director General of Police, Police Headquarter, Sector 6, Panchkula but no action has been taken so far.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra, Haryana to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated 08.05.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
