HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for directing the respondents to provide security to the petitioner or making the necessary arrangement to protect his life during his appearance in the Court.

Perusal of the paper book reveals that the track record of the petitioner does not warrant any interference. As many as 30 FIRs are registered against him and the offences referred in most of the said FIRs are serious in nature. Though in some of the case he has been acquitted, but the other cases are still pending against him. It is an admitted fact that the petitioner is lodged in New District Jail, Nabha and, as such he is already

under the supervision of concerned jail Superintendent. Therefore, plea of the petitioner that he be provided security, cannot be accepted.

In view of the above, this Court finds no merit in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
