This is a petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in First Information Report No. 520 dated 23.11.2013, under sections 406/420/120-B of IPC later on added the offence under Section 419/170/467/468/471 of IPC Act registered at Police Station Tripuri Town Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that a civil suit has been given a criminal colour and the petitioner has been in custody since March 2016. Learned State Counsel has asserted that the petitioner has taken a huge amount of Rs.86,00,000/- odd from the complainant but has resiled from execution of sale deed in favour of the complainant.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of

the case, and keeping in view the period of custody, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the present petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
