Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.120 dated 7.10.2011 under Sections 324,307,148,149 IPC and 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act,PS Mataur,Distt.Mohali.

Petitioner was enlarged on bail and due to his absence on 16.2.2015 he was declared PO on 21.11.2015. It is contended that the petitioner was picked up by the police in another FIR no.41 dated 18.2.2015 at Faridkot and was shown to be in custody from 18.2.2015 to 23.11.2015. Thus, the non-appearance was bona fide.

This Court vide order dated 20.1.2016 while issuing notice of motion for today, directed that in the event of petitioner surrendering before the trial court within ten days he would be released on interim

bail to the satisfaction of the court concerned.

At the time of hearing today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 20.1.2016, petitioner surrendered before the trial court and was released on interim bail.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial court in terms of order dated 20.1.2016 passed by this Court, is made absolute.
