By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.60, dated 19.03.2016, registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 506, 148 read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Punjab Instruments (Control and Noises) Act, 1956, at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

On 20.05.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Counsel would place reliance upon order dated 6.5.2016, passed by this Court in CRM No. M-15734 of 2016 to contend that co-accused Pawandeep Singh Bakshi has been granted ad interim protection as regards arrest. Further submitted that the role attributed to the present petitioner is of having pulled the uniform

of the complainant from the collar and on account of which two buttons of the shirt were broken. No injury is stated to have been attributed to the present petitioner.

Notice of motion, returnable for 16.8.2016.

To be listed along with CRM No. M-15734 of 2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 20.05.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.05.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
