It comes out that the petitioner in his present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeks direction that in case, he is sought to be arrested or detained in connection with any complaint filed by Tarlochan Singh, s/o Sh. Jagir Singh or any other family members of Tarlochan Singh at Ludhiana or at Barnala, he should be given prior notice.

In fact, it amounts to obtaining blanket at anticipatory bail. The petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable for such direction.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file anticipatory bail application/blank anticipatory bail application.
