Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Jagbir @ Kala in case FIR No.131 dated 02.05.2014 for the offences punishable under Sections 395, 397 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

As per the allegations, on 01.05.2014 at about 12:30 PM, complainant-Deepak along with his father were travelling in their Car from Delhi Airport to Fatehabad. At about 2:30 PM, when they reached near Village Madina, one Eco vehicle was stopped in front of their Car. One Sumo vehicle was also stopped behind their Car. Two boys each from both the vehicles came out and took the keys of the Car of the complainant. They snatched Rs.650/-, Licence, PAN Card, ATM and Mobile from the complainant, as also Rs.25,000/- from his father on gunpoint. They also snatched the Car of the complainant.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Rajesh Kumar, submits that recovery of the looted Car and the weapon of offence used in the

commission of crime has been effected from the petitioner/accused. It is further submitted that petitioner is also involved in nine other similar cases.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 01.07.2014.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
