Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.153 dated 16.9.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Maqsudan, Jalandhar City.

This Court vide order dated 31.5.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to

order dated 31.5.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Manjit Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 31.5.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
