AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 847 dated 10.11.2015, under Sections 452, 384, 387, 506, 201, 120-B, 323, 364A, 511 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sirsa.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he had helped the main accused who had tried to kidnap the daughter of the complainant. On the last date the following order was passed:-

“ *Petitioner is alleged to have provided his motor cycle to coaccused who had planned and attempted to abduct the daughter of the complainant for ransom of ₹20 lacs.*

In order to contradict the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is alleged to have only provided motor cycle, it has been urged by State counsel that there is evidence gathered during the course of investigation that the petitioner was in constant touch with the coaccused as per the record of tower locations of the telephone in possession of the accused.

Notice to the State for July 18, 2016.

Copy of the record regarding tower locations and connectivity through telephone be made available on next date of hearing.”

Today learned DAG, on instructions from SI Indraj Singh, has accepted that the tower locations of the phone of the petitioner do not match. The petitioner has been in custody since 10.11.2015.

In the circumstances, without commenting anything on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the present petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
