Petitioner, namely, Dinesh Kumar Gupta, has filed the instant petition under Article 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the complaint (Annexure P-10) titled as **“Surinder Kumar Gupta Vs. Dinesh Kumar and others”**, as well as the summoning order dated 13.2.2010 (Annexure P-11).

Though, today nobody is present on behalf of the petitioner, however, since the complaint titled as **“Surinder Kumar Gupta Vs. Dinesh Kumar Gupta and others”**, has already been dismissed in default by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh, vide order dated 01.12.2014, present petition has been rendered infructuous and is accordingly disposed of as such.

However, in case the complainant succeeds in reviving the complaint, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file fresh petition seeking quashing of the complaint as well as summoning order.
