Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct fair investigation in case FIR No.758 dated 6.10.2015, under Sections 357, 380 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 4.1.2016 to the SHO concerned but no action thereof has been taken. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondents No.1 to 3 to decide the said representation.
